● Korean Language Course

Hosan University's regular Korean language course consists of four semesters in a year. In order to develop the natural communication skills of foreign students, classes conducted with an integrated education system such as reading, listening, speaking, and writing, focusing on communication-oriented teaching methods. Classrooms for various levels from beginner to advanced level are operated, and the number of students in each class is limited to 20 or less for the smooth progress of learners. However, for students who want to learn basic steps such as pronunciation accurately, the course can be opened by adding a preparation step a month before the start of each regular course.
